Dear Glen Rock Dog Park Supporter,

The Glen Rock NJ Dog Park, a 501c3 non-profit organization, is seeking your support to bring a privately funded off-leash Dog Park, **dedicated to the 9/11 Search and Rescue Dogs**, to Glen Rock, New Jersey. In addition to an off-leash play area, the park will work in conjunction with other organizations to host pet adoption days, companion animal training, animal wellness and safety seminars and AKC "Good Citizenship" training.





After working diligently on this project, initiated by a local Girl Scout, for over five years, we recently signed a 10-year lease with the Borough of Glen Rock for a plot of land located at 390 Doremus Avenue with the agreement the park will be completely privately funded.

We've developed a three-phased plan for the park (see attached) and are ready to break ground thanks to the generous donations and pro bono professional services received to date. Funding is still needed for additional landscaping and amenities such as a water fountain, agility equipment, waste disposal bags, trashcans, benches, signage, etc.

Create an eco-friendly, aesthetically pleasing, community friendly, ADA complaint, off-leash canine recreational area (aka "Dog Park") in Glen Rock NJ. The park will be dedicated to the 9/11 Search and Rescue Dogs.

The park is located behind the Glen Rock recycling center @ 390 Doremus Avenue on land leased from the Borough of Glen Rock. The creation of the park is completely privately funded. ***Donations appreciated ☺ and are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.***



The park will incorporate leading edge recycling and energy conservation practices ~ solar panels, solar charging stations, methane digester ~ that we hope will serve as a catalyst for awareness and implementation in other communities across the country.
